

Constitution of the Chinese Liberal Democracy Party (CLDP)

Article 1: Name and Purpose

1.1 Name

The name of the party shall be the **Chinese Liberal Democracy Party (CLDP)**.

1.2 Purpose

The CLDP is committed to:

- 1. Promoting liberal democracy, human rights, and the rule of law in China.
- 2. Representing the interests of the Chinese diaspora in the UK and supporting their democratic rights.
- 3. Advocating for freedom of speech, political pluralism, and civil liberties.
- 4. Supporting democratic movements and individuals persecuted for their beliefs.
- 5. Engaging in lawful political activities in the UK to raise awareness of these causes.

Article 2: Membership

2.1 Eligibility

- Membership is open to anyone aged 16 or over who supports the aims and values of the party.
- Members must not engage in activities that contradict the party's principles.

2.2 Rights of Members

- Members have the right to vote in internal elections.
- Members may stand for leadership positions.
- Members may participate in party meetings and decisionmaking processes.

2.3 Termination of Membership

- Membership may be revoked if a member is found to engage in activities harmful to the party or contrary to its values.
- A disciplinary committee will review cases of misconduct.

Article 3: Leadership and Governance

3.1 Party Officers

The party shall have the following officers:

- **Leader**: Represents the party publicly and sets strategic direction.
- Deputy Leader: Supports the leader and assumes duties in their absence.
- **Treasurer**: Manages finances and ensures compliance with UK political funding laws.
- General Secretary: Oversees administration and internal communications.
- Nominating Officer: Handles candidate selections for elections.

3.2 Executive Committee

- The Executive Committee shall consist of party officers and elected representatives.
- It shall oversee major decisions and policy direction.

3.3 Elections and Terms

- Party officers shall be elected by members every two years.
- Elections shall be conducted democratically through a secret ballot.

Article 4: Party Structure

4.1 Local Branches

- Members may form local branches in different regions to promote the party's goals.
- Each branch shall elect a local committee to coordinate activities.

4.2 Policy Committees

 Policy committees shall be formed to develop party policies in key areas such as human rights, foreign policy, and democracy advocacy.

Article 5: Decision-Making and Meetings

5.1 General Meetings

- An **Annual General Meeting (AGM)** shall be held once per year to review party progress and vote on key issues.
- Extraordinary General Meetings may be called by the Executive Committee or by a petition of at least 20% of members.

5.2 Voting Procedures

• Decisions shall be made by a simple majority vote, except constitutional amendments, which require a two-thirds majority.

Article 6: Finance and Funding

6.1 Financial Management

- The Treasurer shall maintain transparent records of all donations and expenditures.
- The party shall comply with all UK political funding laws.

6.2 Fundraising

- The party may accept donations from individuals and organisations that align with its values.
- No funds shall be accepted from sources that compromise the party's integrity.

Article 7: Code of Conduct

- Members must act with integrity and in accordance with democratic principles.
- Hate speech, violence, and discrimination within the party are strictly prohibited.

Article 8: Amendments to the Constitution

 Amendments to this constitution may be proposed by any member and must be approved by a two-thirds majority vote at a General Meeting.
